

UTS AP Exam Registration 2024-25 FAQs

Am I permitted to write AP exams at UTS?

Students in F1, F2, and M3 are not permitted to write AP exams at UTS (exception of language/culture exams at times). The College Board does not recommend students take AP exams before grade 11. If you are interested in further enrichment in any subject area, you should speak to your teacher of that subject and/or your guidance counsellor.

Students in M4 are permitted to write AP exams only for the AP courses they are enrolled in at UTS. Typically, this is only ICS3UN, which prepares students for the Computer Science Principles exam. If you are enrolled in AP English or AP Pre-Calculus as a UTS M4 - you are eligible to write those exams too.

Students in S5 and S6 are permitted to write up to 4 AP exams at UTS (without further approval). However, we recommend students focus only on 1-3 per year and only take exams for which they have completed the related 4U/M/N/S course. These exams may include:

- a. mandatory AP exams* for -3UP or -4UP courses,
- b. optional AP exams for -3UN, -4UN, or -4US courses,
- c. optional AP exams for subjects in which students are enrolled in the related -4UE course (ie. SBI4UE)
- d. AP exams for a course a student previously completed at UTS

*Students who are enrolled in courses that end in -3UP or -4UP must register for the AP exam in the year that they are enrolled in the course. Enrollment in a -P course includes making a commitment to the AP program of study. Students cannot write these exams early (ie. before taking the course at UTS). Preparation for and completion of the AP exam are integral components of receiving a university-level experience. Further, UTS will provide a tax receipt for these courses only if the student writes (and passes) the AP exam.

How do I sign up for my AP exams at UTS?

Are you in M4?

- A. If you **are not** taking an AP class at UTS, you are not permitted to write AP exams at UTS.
- B. If you **ARE** taking an AP class at UTS (ICS3UN, ENG3UP, Pre-Calculus), you need to do 2 things:
 1. **Ensure you have joined your AP Classroom [here](#).**
Joining your AP classroom provides access to many AP exam preparation resources and it is part of the registration process.
 2. **Submit your exam declaration [here](#) beginning October 1, 2024.**
This form also includes a link to a parent/guardian financial declaration form. The financial declaration form must also be submitted by October 20th, 2024.

Note: you will only be fully registered for the exam if you join the classroom AND submit the AP Exam registration form.

Are you in S5 or S6?

- A. **If you are taking an AP class at UTS (courses ending in -3UN, -4UN, -3UP, -4UR, -4UP, or -4US) and want to write the exam, you must do 2 things (note if your course code ends in P - you must register for the AP exam):**
 1. **Make sure you have joined your AP Classroom [here](#).**
Joining your AP classroom provides access to many AP exam preparation resources (including practice questions) and it is part of the registration process.
 2. **Complete the exam registration form [here](#) beginning October 1, 2024.**
This form also includes a link to a parent/guardian financial declaration form. The financial declaration form must also be submitted by October 20th, 2024.

Note: you will only be fully registered for the exam if you join the classroom AND submit the AP Exam registration form.

- B. **If you want to write an AP exam for a course you are not currently enrolled in at UTS - please submit your exam requests [here](#) beginning September 25th. UTS does not offer AP exams for courses not taught at UTS.**

¹ Exam fees include the exam fee set by College Board as well as test centre fees to support exam administration costs (e.g. room rentals, exam proctors, exam delivery).		
² In case of conflict with the <u>regular testing period</u> date, students may request to write their exams during the late testing period (May 19-23). Such requests will be reviewed by the AP Team and may be subject to a \$75 late testing fee.		

What AP Exams can I write at UTS?

S5 & S6 Students Only. Mandatory Exam AP Course: For any UTS courses that you are enrolled in & end in -P - the exam is a mandatory part of the course & you **must register** for the exam.
