## **Troopers, Converse County Deputies Rescue Missing Montana Teen**

**[Cheyenne, WY] — December 5, 2025**

A Montana teen is home and safe after Troopers track down the men transporting her across state lines. On the evening of November 22nd, the FBI was tracking cell phone pings after a pair of men from Oklahoma picked up a teenage girl in Montana and were traveling with her through Wyoming back to Oklahoma.

Troopers were alerted to the situation via a BOLO alert, and were informed the suspected vehicle was southbound on I-25 and last pinged at mile marker 135. A nearby trooper immediately spotted the suspected vehicle, and, with assistance from Converse County Sheriff's Office, initiated a traffic stop. The trooper spotted the missing girl in the vehicle, and, after taking charge of the investigation, arrested the two suspects.

The 15 year old girl was cared for by the Wyoming Department of Family Services before being returned home to her parents in Montana.

This is still an active investigation and has been handed over to the FBI, no further information will be released at this time.
