1. Respect

- We will bring our full selves, be fully present, and stay engaged during meetings while also taking care of ourselves and our own wellbeing.
- We recognize that everyone has significant contributions to make and will engage in active listening and make space for everyone's voice to be heard.
- We will empower ourselves to speak up and share our experiences, thoughts, and feelings.

3. Learning and Growth

- We commit to approaching conversations with curiosity, not judgment.
- We will speak from our own experience and strive to understand, accept, and trust others' experiences.
- We will recognize our roles, any associated power or privilege, and consider the impacts on others.
- We will take responsibility for our impact and will hold ourselves accountable by being quick to sincerely apologize and open to learning when we do not understand.
- We will lean into discomfort, accept non-closure, and allow continued space and time to grow and reflect.

- We aim to reflect GCC values in our planning and discussions.
- We will honor our commitments to GCC and to its members.
