Below, you will find information on the 2025 Governor's Reading Challenge and Commissioner's Math Challenge to encourage students to continue to learn throughout the summer! Limiting the amount of electronic screen time is helpful as well. It allows for more social and physical interactions amongst their siblings, peers, and you!

One of the most important habits you can nurture in your child is encouraging them to read, whether books or magazines. Summer reading should be fun and relaxing for young and adolescent readers. Mrs. Davis, our new Reading Integration Teacher (Library), is hosting the 2025 Governor's Summer Reading Challenge, in conjunction with our Town Public Library, to encourage children to read over the summer, which can be accessed at the following link: <a href="https://portal.ct.gov/sde/ctread/connecticut-reads">https://portal.ct.gov/sde/ctread/connecticut-reads</a>. On the site, you can find a message to parents and students, additional reading journals, student certificates, and suggested summer reading lists for grades K-2, 3-4, 5-6, and 7-8. Information has been sent home with your child(ren) and a reading journal to keep track of the books read over the summer weeks (hopefully it is made available by their last day of school). New to grades 5-8 have also been provided a specific reading assignment for this summer. The Voluntown Public Library is a great resource for summertime fun!

CSDE also launched the Commissioner's 2025 Summer Math Challenge, <u>Level Up.</u> a free math skills maintenance program for students, which can be accessed at the following link: <a href="https://portal.ct.gov/sde/math/summer-math-challenge">https://portal.ct.gov/sde/math/summer-math-challenge</a>. (K-6 students have also received this in paper form.) On this site, you can find a message for parents and students, a link to register your child(ren) for the challenge, a K-8 summer math log, and other fun activities!
