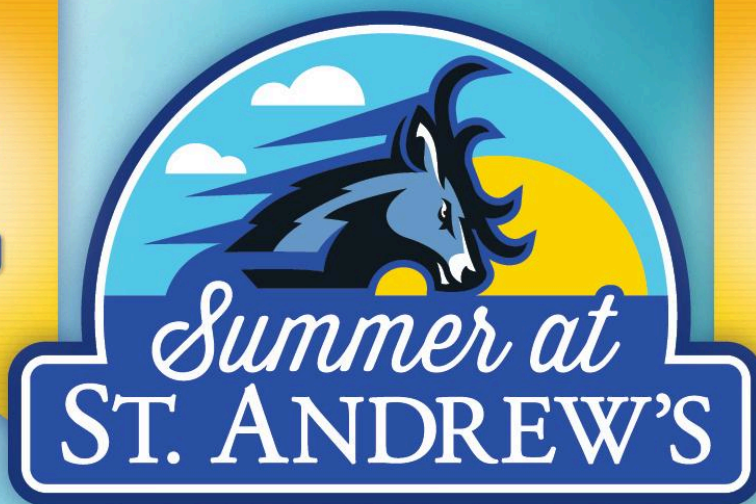

Pages 1-2 - GENERAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Location

Please pay special attention to where your class will be located. The large majority of camps are held at the Lower & Middle School campus, also known as the 31st Street campus. The address to that location is **1112 W. 31st Street, Austin, Texas 78705**. There are also camps and classes at the Upper School campus which is also known as the Southwest Parkway campus, the address to that campus is **5901 Southwest Parkway, Austin, Texas 78735**.

Early Arrival/Aftercare

Summer at St. Andrew's provides early arrival and aftercare supervision for children attending camp at the 31st Street campus only beginning at 8:00 am and concluding at 5:00 pm. These services can be added for \$40 each a week. **There is no early arrival or aftercare at the Southwest Parkway campus.**

Drop-off & Pick-up

For the 31st Street campus, drop-off and pick-up will take place in varying locations on campus depending on which building or wing the specific class takes place in. Individual camp instructors will provide specific info closer to the start date. At Southwest Parkway, students attending theater or arts camps will drop-off at the Dell Fine Arts Center and students attending athletics camps will drop-off and check-in near the athletics fields or gymnasium. More specific details will follow in a subsequent email.

Lunch

Summer at St. Andrew's does not provide lunch for its participants, please be sure to pack a lunch if your child will be attending camp all day. Students will eat a supervised lunch beginning at 12:00 and concluding at 12:45. If your child is registered for a full day of camp this service is free of charge and students will be supervised and guided during transition between morning and afternoon. For those registered for a half day of camp, lunchtime supervision (12:00-1:00) can be added for \$40 a week. **St. Andrew's is a nut-free campus. please avoid sending your child to camp with a lunch or snack that contains any type of nut.**

Class Sizes and Ages

Many of the classes have a minimum and maximum enrollment for the classes to be successful. In the event that the class does not meet minimum enrollment, you'll be notified of the cancellation and be fully refunded. Pre-Kindergarten students attending Summer at St. Andrew's must be at least age four and fully toilet-trained in order to attend.

Cancellation and refund policy

Camp cancellation/refund requests must be emailed to summercamp@sasaustin.org. Cancellations made at least 14 days before a program starts will receive a full refund less a \$50 processing fee. Requests received between 7 to 13 days before the camp starts will be 50% refunded. Refunds will not be issued for requests received less than 7 days in advance of the

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camp start date, except in cases of an emergency. After an individual camp has started, full registration cost is required to switch to a different camp within the same week.

Student Conduct

It is an expectation that all participants of Summer at St. Andrew's conduct themselves in a kind, considerate and respectful manner to their instructors and peers. Disruptive behavior will first be handled by the teacher and then by the Director of Auxiliary Programs. Repeated disruptive behavior may result in a student being dismissed from camp without refund.

Registration

Registration will begin on Wednesday, March 1st at 12pm for St. Andrew's families and Friday, March 3rd for the broader community. Registrations must be completed online - <https://summersasaustin.campbrainregistration.com/>. Please be thorough with food allergies, allergens and medical conditions, especially if signing up for a class that involves food and cooking.
