Information You Need to Understand

Initiate Eligibility

KON is a member of Association of College Honor Societies. As part of our membership, KON complies with the ACHS bylaws which set the standard for member society initiate eligibility. These standards follow.

- Undergraduate students with a GPA of at least 3.3, or rank no lower than the highest 35% of their class and who have completed at least 37.5% of the credits required for their bachelor's degree.
- Graduate students admitted to a degree-granting program and who have completed at a minimum, 12 semester hours, and have a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a 4-point scale.

For the First Initiation – for the Charter

KON recommends a minimum chartering initiation of no fewer than five members.

What you Need to Know to Be a Chapter Advisor

Background

Kappa Omicron Nu is a collegiate honor society serving students in the human sciences. We are a 501c3 non-profit organization. The KON bylaws are posted publicly on the KON website and define how we operate.

KON's mission is to promote empowered leaders through excellence in scholarship, leadership, and research in the human sciences. Our vision includes lifelong opportunities for professional and personal growth through networking, education, and service. We value strong affiliate networks, continuing advancement in one's profession, and recognition of quality scholarship, leadership, and research.

Chapters may make the guidelines narrower but not broader. Chapters are required to comply with KON's Policies. The national initiation fee is currently \$60 per initiate, which is periodically adjusted by the national Board of Directors.

Chapter Responsibilities

Chapter advisers are responsible for the following. While many of our chapters have students conduct much of the work of running the chapter as an opportunity for leadership, service, and professional development, the chapter adviser ensures the following activities are completed.

- ✓ Annually complete required forms updating financial information and reporting on reporting chapter programming, initiate numbers, adviser and leader contact information, etc.
- ✓ Hold an initiation annually.
- ✓ Report all initiates to the national office utilizing the online management system provided.
- ✓ Ensure any national initiate funds collected by the chapter are submitted to the national office. Any funds collected by a chapter in KON's name will return to the national office in the event the chapter closes. Any funds collected by the chapter in KON's name will be spent reasonably on KON-related activities.
- ✓ At a minimum, fill the roles of student Chapter President, name a member to be the Delegate to Conclave (annual meeting) for voting on behalf of the chapter, have an annual service project, and hold meetings.
- ✓ Other chapter leadership positions are also encouraged such as Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and so forth.
- ✓ Chapter advisers are encouraged to participate and support national office activities such as serving as board member, committee member, or participate on a committee.

KON's chapters vary in what types of programs each chapter adopts. Some of our chapters have robust community service, leadership, fundraising, social and networking opportunities, or even give their own scholarships and awards.

Chapters may meet in person and/or virtually. Chapters sometimes use a points-based system for its own awards and record-keeping, and may use activities affiliated with KON nationally, or college or university-sponsored events, provided the chapter adviser supports their involvement with scholarship, leadership, research, or service.

Statements of Faculty Support

At a minimum, the applying advisor(s) must have at least one letter of support from the Department Head, Dean, or President, depending on the level of institutional approval determined by their university's governance system at their university. The letter of support must carry a "wet" signature and be provided at the time of application.

Timeline

Once an application has been submitted to office@kon.org:

- Receipt will be acknowledged by email within two working days; if you have not received acknowledgement within two working days, send an email to execdir@kon.org as follow up in case someone is on vacation
- Once received, it is reviewed within a week (Review #1) and you will receive an email to set up an initial call to review your application, ask for any missing information, allow you to ask any questions you may have, and discuss whether the application will be forwarded to the Board for their review and consideration. Their review takes about one week (Review #2).
- If the Board of Directors reviews and accepts the application, by the KON Bylaws, the application is then sent to existing Chapters for their confirmation. This takes about another week (Review #3).
- If the application passes all three reviews, it is time to set your first initiation and the important Chapter installation. A member of the Board and/or the KON Executive Director will attend to do the installation. This important chapter event may be done live at your university, online, or hybrid. If

possible and the Chapter has funds, a Board member or the Executive Director can be there in person at a mutually agreed date, or the representative of the Board will attend virtually. A PowerPoint presentation will be used for the Installation.
