

NHS/NTHS Selection Process

The selection process for the BCTHS chapter of NHS/NTHS is as follows:

- 1) Each fall the school will generate a list of students in 11th and 12th grade who have a GPA that meets the requirements for membership acceptance. The GPA used will be the final GPA from the school year prior. (10th grade final for 11th graders and 11th grade final for 12th graders).
- 2). The students meeting GPA requirements will be sent invitations to apply via email.
- 3) The applications received by the deadline will be reviewed by a panel of teachers.
- 4) Students who have met all requirements and are deemed accepted by the panel of teachers will be sent a letter congratulating them on acceptance and inviting them to the induction ceremony. Students who have not been deemed accepted will be sent a denial letter.
- 5) Students in attendance of the Induction Ceremony and sworn in will officially be deemed members.

Criteria for meeting NHS/NTHS requirements are as follows :

NHS GPA= 3.75 unweighted or 4.25 weighted GPA

NTHS =3.6 unweighted or 4.0 weighted GPA + a 95% average in technical program.

- Staff Recommendations from 1 Academic and 1 Technical staff member
- Minimum of 20 approved , documented community service hours.(accumulated the school year prior to nomination August- July)
- A student shall not exceed a total of four (4) combined instances of unexcused absences, tardies, or early dismissals per semester.
- Behavior must meet character requirements.
- Minimum one leadership position.

Members will be expected to pay a small fee for the NHS/NTHS graduation apparel.
