If a move up requires you to enter additional levels, payment will be expected and the amount owed will be based on entry period you originally entered during (so, if entered during pre-entry then \$22, if late entry \$27, if DOS \$32

Entries are not complete until payment is received and if entering Brace teams are completed, this must be done by competitors.

Dog Registration:

Dogs must be registered with the North American Sport Dog Association to participate. Registration is a one-time fee of \$25.00. You will first need to complete a New User Registration to create an account [New User Registration – North American Sport Dog Association](#) You may then register your dog to get a NASDA Registration # Assigned [Registration – North American Sport Dog Association](#)

Awards:

Flat ribbon awards are self-served at the conclusion of each trial. Flat ribbons for Qualifying Score, and High in Class will be available. Please see the Trial Secretary if a New Title is earned for a New Title rosette with custom class/level tab. No Versatility ribbons available at this trial.

Venue:

Competitors need to park in the designated parking area and will crate out of their vehicles. There will be no food vendors on site so bring any items you will need for you and your dog to be content throughout the duration of the trial day. We will have a porta potty for use during the event. No alcohol, drug or tobacco use on site.

Notice to Exhibitors:

- You **must** have a Brace partner determined before you enter the trial, if you have 2 dogs you are running together you **must** have a 2nd handler determined before you enter the trial, and must be listed as the handler for each run. Your Brace entries are not complete until you complete pairing the dogs onto a team, which is done in your dashboard after you complete payment for your entry. One dog must create a team and the other must join the team, so communicating with your Brace partner on who is doing what part is important.
- Refunds for 75% of your entry fee total will be processed within 48 hours of pre-entry closing as long as your request is properly submitted via Secreterrier no later than **September 3rd, 2026, 11:59pm PST**.
- No refunds will be made for cancellations for any reason after **September 4th, 2026, 12:00am PST** or to entrants which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee. **Monroe's Mischief** reserves the right to remove any individual for any reason from the premises. No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather

conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club. *If the Club must cancel the event, every effort will be made to reschedule and entries will be transferred to the rescheduled event, otherwise an option of credit for full entry fee's amount will be given for a future event.*

- **Monroe's Mischief** reserves the right to refuse any entry without cause or explanation.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete and accurate information of their entries. Entries must be accompanied by payment. A missing or declined payment does not constitute a valid entry.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- All dogs must be on a short leash (10 feet or less) except when competing, at which time a longer leash is permitted.
- Exhibitors are responsible for attending the handler walk throughs and being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.
- BIS will be allowed to participate per NASDA rules, a separate potty area will be designated, and they will run last in the run order. BIS are always required to wear well fit panties, other than when being taken potty. If you own a dog competing and they become a BIS, you must notify the Trial Secretary immediately.
- **A general briefing will be held each day at 9:00am with a 9:30am trial start time.** Exact class order each day will be determined based on entry numbers and will be shared once pre-entries close in the final email confirmation which will be sent no later than September 15th.
- Your online submission will ask for a signature to complete your entry; by signing you are agreeing to the above notices to exhibitors.
