Lieut. Herman Meyer, 31 Boyd street, returned yesterday to this city following a period of service in the medical corps of the army for about two years. He was stationed in a hospital in France.

Dr. Meyer has been located at the La Crosse hospital and is in the service of the United States army with the rank of first lieutenant. He formerly attended the Oshkosh High and Normal schools.

Dr. Herman Meyer Dies at Marshfield

Information has been received here of the death of a former Oshkosh resident, Dr. Herman C. Meyer, 69, Tuesday morning at St. Joseph's Hospital, Marshfield. He had been a practicing physician at Necedah for many years.

He was born in Oshkosh on June 22, 1887, attended Oshkosh High School and the old Normal School before going to University of Wisconsin and later graduating from Rush Medical School, Chicago.

Dr. Meyer served with the Medical Corps overseas in World War I, and following his return to this country went to Necedah to practice. He was married in 1921 to Miss Theodora Nagel in Mayville.

Surviving are his wife, Theodora; one son, Dr. John Meyer, Covina, Calif.; one daughter, Mrs. Rosemary Plymesser, Clairmont, Calif.; one sister, Miss Minnie Meyer, of 31 Boyd St. in Oshkosh; and four grandchildren.
