Dual Credit Classes for Technical Schools – Juniors & Seniors

- Registration for Fall semester is opening on November 1st.
 Spring Semester runs from January 9th- May 5th
- Enrollment is limited to three courses (9 credits) per semester. First time students are limited to one (3 credits).
- Cost for tuition, books and supplies is student's responsibility. Tuition is \$48.33/credit
- It is required by the SD Board of Regents (SDBOR) that student's scores will be recorded on both their high school and college transcripts.

Take note – The SDBOR has a policy: Students are limited to 6 withdrawals during their collegiate career. To be specific this would be receiving a W for withdrawal rather than a D for Drop. A drop occurs in the time period for a 100% refund and a withdrawal occurs outside of that time frame. I recommend students only take Dual Credit classes if they are prepared to work at the collegiate level and have their academic goal set for an A or B. Students do not want to begin their college career with anything less than a 3.0 college GPA.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Approval of parent, high school principal and counselor. Based on GPA, attendance and academic goal.

A. Begin Registration

- 1. All students must meet with the high school counselor to confirm eligibility and course selection.

 ***Deadline to meet with Mr. Breske December 16th NO EXCEPTIONS
- 2. Students will receive an Approval Form to be signed by student and parent in order to complete the registration process.

- 4. Return Approval Form & DC Agreement Form to Mr. Breske Deadline December 16th NO EXCEPTIONS

B. Students Complete Registration

- 1. After returning approval form to Mr. Breske, he will give students a link to complete registration.
- 2. After registration, students will receive confirmation email with all info included for taking the course check your email frequently!
 - Tip: Do not wait to order books you will want your books in hand for the first day of semester!
- 3. Billing information will be sent from the Tech school to your email at the beginning of the semester about how and when to pay your bill online.
