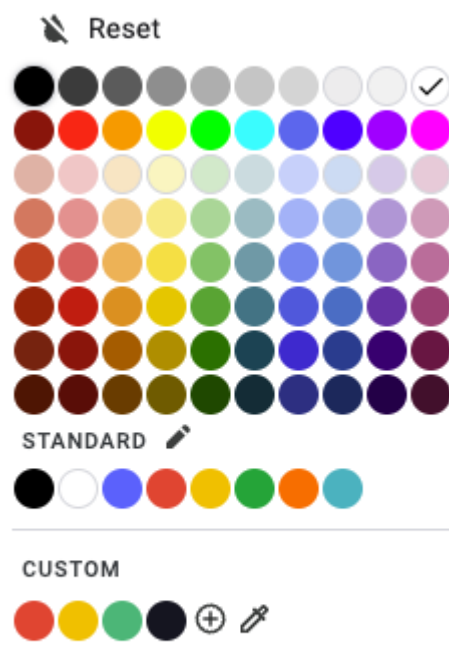


So you've made your SDCA system but want a better-looking gauge?

This guide assumes you've made the essential gauge already.

Then, follow the steps below.

1. Add a Line Chart.
2. In a blank cell, multiply the aggregate valuation by -1 to use as the data range for this gauge.
3. Configure the Line Chart so you see the valuation.
4. Go to Gridlines & Ticks and set Major Count to 9.
5. Go to Vertical Axis, select Custom for Numbering Format, and use “-#.0;#.0.”
6. Add colours to the chart by modifying the cell background colour.

7. Where you want to place your Line chart, number the cells 2 to -2 and use conditional formatting by highlighting the cells, clicking on the bucket, selecting conditional formatting, and then using a colour scale to change the cell colours.
8. Change the text colour to the colour of the conditionally formatted cells to mask the text.
