The company explains that the personal information of the company's customers has been obtained due to unfortunate data leaks, but it is still unknown how many people have been leaked. The leaked information includes details associated with the user profile, such as name, contact, date of birth, social security number, player ID, screen name, account identifier, transaction details, etc.

Adam Greenblatt, CEO of BetMGM, said, "We encourage customers to be alert to unsolicited communications regarding their personal information and review their accounts for suspicious activities. We took our privacy obligations very seriously and arranged for affected customers to provide credit monitoring and identity recovery services for two years at no cost. The reference guide below provides information on what you can do to protect your information."

The company provided all the necessary information related to their contacts to help users ask questions about their accounts and keep them informed.
