We want to share with you an opportunity for you to create innovative projects that we will review and potentially fund through our newly created ESSER Innovation Fund. This fund directly provides a response to items 2, 3, and 5 listed above. Have a great idea to engage our diverse learners and would like to apply for funding to put this idea into action? This is YOUR opportunity! While we may not be able to fund every single project, we will review each application based on the level of detail provided in the application, the criteria for ESSER allocation, and amount of funding requested.
