How do students show they are being safe at school?

- Listen to teachers

- Don't purposely kick someone while you're on the swing

How do adults show they are being safe at school?

- Reminds kids of safety rules and procedures
- By saying kind words and if someone gets hurt they ask them if they need to go to the nurse
- If someone is not feeling go, their teacher might see it and ask if they're okay
- Kind to other teachers and kids
- Don't yell or hit people if they do something bad on accident
- They don't run

How do students show kindness at school? Give examples.
