How to Buy Extra Storage on Zoom for your Recorded Videos

Step 1: Sign in to Your Zoom Account

- Open your web browser and go to Zoom's official website.
- Click on the "Sign In" button at the top-right corner of the page.
- Enter your email and password, then click "Sign In."

Step 2: Navigate to the Billing Section

- Once you're signed in, hover over your profile picture at the top-right corner.
