English III is a college prep class in which students work to improve their skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking in accordance with the California Common Core State Standards. The focus is American Literature, which corresponds to U.S. History.

Possible Major Works Covered (this list could change):

- The Great Gatsby by F. Scott Fitzgerald
- The Poetry of Emily Dickinson
- A Raisin in the Sun by Lorraine Hansbury
- The Catcher in the Rye by J.D. Salinger

In addition to some of the core works listed above, students will be reading a variety of fiction and nonfiction, including current events. We will be practicing strategies for evaluating sources and will engage in civil dialogue. Throughout the year we will be covering vocabulary, writing strategies, and exercises in grammar and usage and preparing for the Common Core State testing.

Homework and Grading

Students can expect to have homework approximately three days per week. Should there be no written homework students are expected to read assigned texts outside of class. Parents and students are welcome to use Aeries, our online program, to keep up with grades and attendance. The following is an approximate percentage breakdown of the total grade:

Classwork/Homework: 30% Participation 10% *Formal Assessment: 60%

*Formal Assessment includes tests, formal essays, speeches, collaborative projects and presentations.

The grading scale is:

90-100 = A 80-89 = B 70-79 = C 60-69 = D

Make-Up Work and Late Work

- Make up work will be accepted for EXCUSED ABSENCES ONLY. Absences must be cleared through attendance to get credit for missed work. You will not be able to turn in work for unexcused absences/truancies.
- Late work (meaning you were here, but did not turn assignment in on time) will receive HALF CREDIT if turned in within 2 days. After 2 days it is not accepted.

Materials

Students should bring the following items to class every day:

- paper
- pens and pencils
- a two-pocket folder or a binder in which to keep handouts/assignments
- the novel which we are currently reading
- **SSR** reading material. In addition to 4th period SSR, we will be reading and reflecting in our writing journals **every Tuesday**.
- NOTE: Parents/guardians are responsible for the content of SSR reading material.

Also suggested: small Post-it notes and highlighters for close reading and note-taking

Discipline Policy

I enforce school and District policies as defined in your Student Handbook. I also enforce school tardy and restroom use policy.

Class rules are as follows:
