

# **Author Interview With KG Fletcher by Itsy Bitsy Book Bits**

For those new to your work, please tell us a bit about yourself, your books and your genre/s

- I'm a full-time indie artist as a romance author, and a backup singer in a national tour. I bring my laptop everywhere I go. I'm always writing on trains, planes, automobiles, backstage, hotel rooms, etc. I write contemporary romance and romantic suspense with ALL THE FEELS! I have ten published books (2 series & 3 standalones) I'm also the narrator for all of my audio books. I have a BFA in theater & have done voiceover work in the past.

What lessons have you learned as a writer?

- It's a marathon. I work 8-10 hours as a fulltime writer every single day. It's all on me. If I don't do it no one else will. You have to be consistent and show up day in and day out. Never ever give up!

If you won the lottery what would you do with the money?

- Pay off my son's college loans - rent a cruise ship & invite all of my family & friends to celebrate! Give to my fav charity, Make-A-Wish.

In your everyday life how do you give back to the world?

- I always try to post or share something positive on social media. I'm a love promotor, so my mantra is based on #lovewins - we must show love & kindness to all!

If your life was a song what song would it be and why?

- Love Wins by Carrie Underwood - like I said, #lovewins is my mantra.
