Description of the issue:

After our last CTA on the ERA, President Biden called on Congress to immediately enshrine the Equal Rights Amendment in the U.S. Constitution and formally protect women's rights nearly a century after lawmakers first raised them. In a statement, Biden urged Congress "to pass a resolution recognizing ratification of the ERA," saying recent legal analysis showed there was nothing preventing lawmakers from acting.

Congresswoman Jackie Speier (CA-14), Co-Chair of the Democratic Women's Caucus, and Congresswoman Carolyn B. Maloney (NY-12), Chairwoman of the Oversight and Reform Committee, unveiled a resolution recognizing that the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) has met all legal requirements to be recognized as the 28th Amendment to the Constitution. As of today, the ERA will guarantee long-sought constitutional protections against sex discrimination, and further empower Congress to enact legislation advancing gender equity. The resolution marks the two-year anniversary of Virginia's ratification of the ERA, the date the ERA is slated to go into effect. The resolution is cosponsored by 133 Members of the U.S. House of Representatives.
