Key Policies We Follow

As part of our EA and UK Athletics affiliation, we follow a range of policies designed to protect and support everyone involved in the club. These include:

- Safeguarding Adults Policy – protecting all adults, including those who may be vulnerable.
- Codes of Conduct – for athletes, coaches, volunteers, and club leaders.
- Disciplinary & Grievance Procedures – clear processes for raising and resolving issues.
- Inclusion Policy – promoting inclusivity and tackling discrimination.
- Health & Safety – keeping our training sessions and events safe.

All members of TRC are expected to abide by these.
