Tapiwanashe Kujinga is the Director of the Pan-African Treatment Access Movement (PATAM). He has worked on, among other interventions, HIV and AIDS, diagnostics, Covid-19, medicines regulation, intellectual property rights and access to medicines for the last 30 years. In 2015, PATAM started the Zimbabwe antimicrobial resistance program, and Tapiwanashe worked in a number of capacities in the program. He was a member of the AMR National Core Group, chairperson of the Education & Awareness technical working group and head of the national AMR secretariat. PATAM is working with other partners to raise awareness on AMR among civil society organisations and the media.
