Pre-Reading Questions

Respond to these questions before reading the article. (5 minutes)

1 - Based on your current understandings of autism, what are some challenges that people with this disability face?

3 - While you read the article, underline sentences in which Suskind quotes people and sources.

Just shy of his 3rd birthday, an engaged, chatty child, full of typical speech — "I love you," "Where are my Ninja Turtles?" "Let's get ice cream!" — fell silent. He cried, inconsolably. Didn't sleep. Wouldn't make eye contact. His only word was "juice."
