SUMMARY

The Cornerstone Kids (CKids) Team Member joyfully shows God's love by welcoming children into CKids, helping create and maintain a safe environment for children, and partnering with the Team Lead and Service Lead for the gathering to help the children engage with the lesson and understand the gospel.

COMMITMENT

- Commit to serving once in a four week period for at least 6 months.
- Review the lesson prior to serving and come prepared.
- Arrive at 9:15 AM for the 10 AM gathering to pray and prep with team.
- Stay 10-15 minutes after serving to ensure proper cleanup.
- Commit to helping serve at a Prayer Night or Members Meetings once a year (September-August).
- Participate in appropriate CKids trainings throughout the year.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Prayerfully seeking after Jesus daily through regular rhythms of grace.
- Actively participate in the life of the church for at least six months.
- Have a passion for welcoming new families and building relationships with existing families.
- Able to speak and play with children in age-appropriate ways.
- Submit a CKids application, pass a background check, complete Abuse Awareness training, and participate in an interview/orientation.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Contribute to a joyful, God-centered, kid-focused environment.
- Reaffirm, model and apply gospel truth that is taught in an age-appropriate manner.
- Participate in lessons, singing, crafts, memory verses, and purposeful play.
- Take kids to the restroom as needed, always having two adults where a child is present.
- Shepherd children through structured learning time using the provided curriculum.
- Report to the police, and then to the CKids overseeing elder, any observed abuse toward a child or minor.
- Coordinate with CKids Admin and fellow team members via email and Planning Center for scheduling.
- Engage with new parents/families by welcoming them into CKids.
- Pray regularly for volunteers and families.
