John Labeta

- Cross league football games
  - i. Encourage schools to work with each other early to change games
  - ii. Cross leaguing with Grossmont /City and Metro conferences for the 27-28 Football season
- o Student athlete summit 11/19/25 @ San Pasqual High from 9 to 12 a.m.
  - i. Meeting 10/9 to work on the summit
- Saint Joseph's requesting to join the NCC for gymnastics only/ Southern section team / southern section recognizes gymnastics as sport but will not have CIF championships due to lack of teams within the section.

# Athletic Directors voted this down at our meeting Tuesday. 20 against 2 for

- i. The feeling was they didn't want a southern section team to win league championships designed for San Diego schools
- ii. No Principal vote needed
- All league changes for the NCC
  - i. Only affects certain sports (i.e. goalie of the year for soccer and field hockey)
  - ii. 33% increase in number of students being recognized
  - iii. 5 sports are increasing the number of all league recognitions
- Flag football rules and inconsistency with officiating- discussion at AD meeting
  - i. Rules are state rules not CIFSDS rules
  - ii. No representative at the state level to look at the rules
  - iii. Officials are adjusting to the new rules for 2025 season

- Reminder league champs are no longer guaranteed entry into the playoffs for a home game. Revision to the Red book to allow the NCC in the case of a tie for league championship and if necessary to award the league championship to a team outside the playoff bracket in order to qualify for a play-in game.
  - i. There are instances where leagues can co champs or tri champs
    - 1. Looking at different language for these instances
- Concern expressed by athletic directors over AED availability for cross country and golf.
  - i. Approached with an E bike idea for cross country (Valley Center uses one)
  - ii. State bylaws state 3 minutes away for availability of AED
  - iii. Issues that some schools and districts aren't purchasing enough AEDs to go with golf and cross country
    - 1. Westview is having some issues
    - 2. Canyon Crest has begun to scale up
    - 3. Ramona states every district has different guidances for approved AEDs
    - 4. Ron (CIF) is working on his end to find some solutions
