- 2. Is my information secure with Clarity?
 - a. MCH takes the privacy and security of your personal information very seriously. Clarity is certified for both GDPR and SOC2 and uses enterprise-level security standards including end-to-end encryption of all personally identifiable information.  - a. You must submit your full completed application by January 12, 2024 for returning families and February 15, 2024 for new families.
