 - #1 ranked school in the US for social mobility
 - Strong support for 1st generation/low-income students

 - 4100 Humanities Gateway, Irvine CA 92697
 - Access to Hollywood and downtown LA
 - Traffic congestion and parking issues
 - Expensive housing off campus
 - Urban living with suburban and nature experiences nearby
 - Location allows for industry internships
- ☐ Population/Diversity
 - Large Campus – over 37,000 students, just over 7,000 graduate students
 - Diverse student population with an Asian majority of 37%
 - Larger female population
 - Most students from California – Liberal?
 - Lots of cross-cultural support programs
- ☐ Majors
 - Science based majors are impacted Biology, Psychology, Computer Science
 - Graduate majors include Writing, Comparative Literature, **Film and Media Studies**
 - UCI is a research-based University
 - School of Humanities has @ 300 grad students
- ☐ Athletics/Organizations
 - More than 600 student organizations
 - On campus and local theaters and galleries
 - Student run newspaper/radio station
 - D1 Basketball and Baseball
 - Various intercollegiate club team sports
 - **Langston Library**
- ☐ Acceptance Requirements/Rates
 - Nearly 75% graduation rate in 4 years
 - About 75% of UCI students receive financial aid (scholarships, grants, loans, work study)
 - **Required BA with a 3.0 GPA**
 - **Also consider subject participation, scholarship, letters of rec, test scores (GRE), and examples of work**
 - Earning degree requires thesis dissertation
- ☐ Living Situation
 - Off campus housing requirement increases cost
 - 3 on campus apartment communities for Graduate students
 - \$1400-\$2400 monthly for 1 bedroom

 - 1410 NE Campus Parkway, Seattle, WA 98195
 - 3 campuses in
 - Seattle – City with competitive research focus and large more traditional college experience
 - Tacoma – Historical city vibe with transfer and local students outside Seattle
 - Bothell – Suburban with focus on experiential, hand on teaching with smaller classes
 - Near vast wilderness; forests, mountains, waterfalls, etc.
 - Near family
- ☐ Population/Diversity
 - Predominantly white (33%) and asian (27%) students
 - Minimal out of state representation (23%)
 - 43% of student claim “other” gender
 - Large campus, over 57,000 students
 - #1 Most Diverse College in Washington
