Why do we process your personal data?

The University of Deusto processes the data provided to manage the processes relating to security breaches in data protection, determining the nature of the potential impact on individuals, the severity of the consequences and the measures adopted.

What is the lawful basis for processing your personal data?

The legal basis for processing your data is the fulfilment of a legal obligation applicable to the controller, as set out in Article 6(1)(c) of the General Data Protection Regulation.

Who will be the recipients of your personal data?

Those required by law within the scope of this processing

They do not fall within the scope of this processing

How long is my information kept?

Personal data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose, to determine possible responsibilities and to process administrative or jurisdictional appeals.

What are your rights when you provide your personal data to us?

Any person will have the right to obtain from the UNIVERSITY OF DEUSTO confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed.

Those concerned have the right to request access to their personal data and rectification of inaccurate data or, where that is the case, request erasure of personal data when, among other reasons, the data are no longer necessary for the purposes they were collected for.

In some circumstances, those concerned may request restriction of processing of personal data, in which case these will only be stored for the exercise or defence of legal claims.

In certain circumstances or for reasons related to a specific situation, those concerned may object to the processing of their personal data. In this case, The UNIVERSITY OF DEUSTO will no longer process the data, unless the centre responsible demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing, or for the exercise or defence of legal claims.

Those concerned may request data portability to receive personal data concerning them which have been provided to the UNIVERSITY OF DEUSTO in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format, to be downloaded by them or transmitted directly from the UNIVERSITY OF DEUSTO to another entity.

The interested party may exercise their rights by sending their request to the postal or email address indicated in the section on identification of the person responsible, or by email to privacidad@deusto.es

Furthermore, in the event of disagreement with the University of Deusto regarding the exercise of your rights, you may contact the University's Data Protection Officer by email at dpo@deusto.es

You may lodge a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Agency, especially when you have not obtained satisfaction in the exercise of your rights, at the postal and/or email address indicated on its website: www.aepd.es
