<b>Suicide Prevention/Intervention</b>	<a href="#">Youth SAVE</a> *Recommended to have two people, per school building trained in Youth SAVE.	Administrators, Counselors, & Other School-Based Mental Health Professionals	9 Hours	3-5 Years
<b>Suicide Postvention</b>	<a href="#">Connect Postvention</a>	Administrators, Counselors, & Other School-Based Mental Health Professionals	6 Hours	5 Years
<b>Crisis Response</b>	Crisis Response Coordination A WESD training designed to equip school staff with the tools and guidance to lead a crisis response in their school building immediately following a traumatic event. <b>Behavioral Safety Assessment (Threat/SIRC)</b>	Level I Behavior Safety Assessment A WESD training designed to equip school staff with the tools and guidance on the Level I protocols for the threat and sexual incident assessment process.	Administrators, Counselors, & Other School-Based Mental Health Professionals	8 Hours	3-5 Years (4 Hour Refresher)
