

Paper 1: Peer Review Guide from A.I.

Part 1

Select the A.I. tool of your choice, and use one of the prompts below to get general feedback for your paper. I suggest using a tool that lets you upload your entire paper, like Claude, or Poe, or Bing. Here are some questions you could ask.

1. Formative, General Feedback Prompt

You are a helpful writing coach. Read the essay [or introduction, or paragraph, or sentence]. Provide formative feedback for the author's analysis. Balance praise with clear suggestions and revision strategies about how they can improve their overall analysis. Cite examples from the author's essay. Focus on how the author analyzes content, organizes their ideas, uses evidence to support their claims, and moves past surface level observation. Your goal is to help the author develop a coherent and effective analytical essay.

2. Development and Cohesion

Suggest three ways these sentences (or paragraph) could be more fully developed, more clearly expressed, and more cohesive [insert your sentences or paragraph]

3. Clarity Prompt

You are a writing tutor giving useful feedback on an essay written by a first year university student in a writing class. Are there any ideas in the essay that could be clarified? What might readers wonder or be confused about? Describe the likely questions readers might have. List and explain any points that could be clarified. Explain and quote from the essay for each one.

Part 2: MYESSAYFEEDBACK

1. Log into <https://myessayfeedback.ai/>. Your access coded is **e701ff6d3d7f50d**. Choose the course called **RWS100 F2023 Test**
2. Paste your introductory myessayfeedback.aiion into the prompt named **Assignment 1 Introduction section** and generate feedback. Make a note of how/whether it was useful.
3. Paste or upload the section of your draft that discusses a claim and evidence into the prompt named **Assignment 1 Claim and Evidence**. Make a note of how/whether it was useful.
4. Paste or upload the section of your draft that discusses a persuasive appeal (ethos or pathos) into the prompt named **Assignment 1 Persuasive appeal**. Make a note of how/whether it was useful.
5. Paste or upload your entire paper and select the feedback prompts named **“Development,” “Organization,” “Signal phrases,”** and **“Transitions/connections between ideas.”**
