Release times are **ESTIMATED**. Times vary due to test instructions, breaks, testing material collection...etc. Large groups may take longer. Afternoon test start times may vary based on the dismissal time from the morning test. Students are still required to check in on time. **Students with accommodations - you will be in a different testing room and end times may vary.**

Students MUST know their College Board log-in to take all AP exams this year. You cannot bring it on a piece of paper - you must know it! Late testing will not be an option for students that can't remember their log-in.

WHAT TO BRING: All items need to be in a clear Ziploc bag. You will not access your bag till after the exam.

- **CHARGED** School Issued Chromebook - **NO PERSONAL DEVICES.**
- **Hardcopy Photo I.D. - not digital on your phone!**
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing and sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers for free-response questions in hybrid or paper exams.
- (Optional) A calculator with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics(s). **There is one built into the test with the exception of AP STATS.**
- Water is allowed in a **clear container with the label removed.** **CLEAR PLASTIC ONLY - no stickers!!**

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- **NO FOOD!** If you have two back to back tests, you may hand a sack lunch to a proctor but you won't have access until the first test is complete.
- **NO CELL PHONES,** Smartwatch, earbuds, AI glasses or any other electronic device. **DO NOT BRING THEM!**
- **NO Backpacks, purses, wallets, satchels** (etc.) **Leave them in your locker, car, a classroom or at home.**
- Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes
- Rulers and straightedges - they will be provided
- Scratch paper - It will be provided for you.
- Personal computers. **(School issued Chromebook ONLY)**
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Portable listening or recording devices (even with headphones) or photographic equipment
- Clothing with subject-related information and **NO HATS OR HOODED SWEATSHIRTS.**
