## Read.gov VS eBook lesson plan

Grade Level & Subject Area:1st gradeReading
Standards/Framework (State Standards, Content Standards, InTASC Standards)
RL.1.9 Compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in stories.
Theme/Series of Lessons (if Not applicable, put N/A. They will be reading 2 stories on read.gov. "The tortoise and the hare", and "the dog and his reflection". Once the class has read the two stories, On a google document using their chromebooks, the students will compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in stories. Once they have done this, they will turn it in to google classroom.
Time (is this a 1 day 50 minute lesson, 5 day 1 hour lesson, once a week over a month lesson): This lesson will take place over the course of 3 days.
Day 1: The students will read the tortoise and the hare
Day 2: the students will read the dog and his reflection
Day 3: The students will compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in stories.
What do the students already know? (This could be the Intro or they have learned information before starting this lesson): The students already know how to identify characters, setting, and the plot.

Objective (What are the students' going to accomplish): The students will compare and contrast the two stories, "the tortoise and the hare" and "the dog and his reflection. They will compare them in a google document using their chromebooks.

Materials: tablet, Computer, and read.gov

## **Procedure:**

• TTW begin by telling all students to sit in their desks and take their tablet/lpad out.

- TTW tell the students the objectives for this lesson and explain what they will be doing
- TTW ask the students if they have any questions
- TS will go to the site read.gov
- TS will read tortoise and the hare.
- TS will read the dog and his reflection.
- TS will compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in stories.
- TS will get out their chromebooks
- TS will compare and contract using their computers in a google document.
- After the student has compared and contrasted the two stories, they will turn the document into google classroom.

Assessment (How will the students' show you that the objective has been met):
