PPP were open to the idea and once PCF stated that they are happy to play as only one of their players in una, they approached KFANDRA and KFANDRA gave the all clear as there would be enough players ava for loans and more for MDD's.

The match between TT and PCF on the 28th of Jan. has been preponed to the 7th of Jan. while NSTTP v PPP has been postponed to the 28th of January.

Protests by KFANDRA players who have no progeny! (This article was published on 03/01/23)

Quite a few of the KFANDRA squad protested when they heard that KFANDRA surprised a few of their members when the KLC4 kits were distributed. (Those players whose kids are still at a young age, were given extra shirts for the kids and those players wives that had requested a shirt, were gifted one too.)

PPP issues! (This article was published on 06/01/23)

When real-life swoops down to disrupt the KFANDRA plans, KFANDRA is always prepared, because the players are prepared too. Even if some issues could be difficult to combat.

PPP have been hit with two casualties, one being Chakraborty who couldn't live up to the current fitness standards required of a KFANDRA player and has been pushed into the NSTTP side to work on his fitness. Unfortunately, he's taken another break and it's definitely unlikely that he can recover before the end of the season. Not only that, but he's been unable to keep up with the constant happenings at KFANDRA, which is a must to be officially ordained as a 'pakka' KFANDRA member. Another player that has disappointed PPP is Kadam. After giving his word to be ava for PPP, real-life has caught up with him and apart from the training sessions, Kadam is unlikely to be ava for matches. This will probably mean he'll also be shifted to the NSTTP. This leaves the new player Pancholi who has been rocked to the core at the high levels of training held at KFANDRA. Khare does believe that this 'giant' of a player can have a massive impact on any KFANDRA Club if he was given one to play for, but only if he is able to up his fitness levels and lose the baggage he carries which he picked up when playing regularly with non-KFANDRA players. Currently, he's been moved to the NSTTP, but depending on his work over the next week or two, KFANDRA may just push him into the PPP side. KFANDRA has stated that whenever ava, these players 'without' a Club, will get to play the 'full game time' whenever NSTTP play.

Rumours abound that some old players of Khare are interested in joining KFANDRA, which would mean that there would be an excess number of players ava for the number of Clubs involved. If this were to happen, NSTTP would be forced to open its doors. But that's a story for another day, for who's

to say that those new players will even get to play if their fitness levels are poor.

KFANDRA goes cray-cray on Foxes and Turtles! (This article was published on 10/01/23)

KFANDRA released a statement to the Press a few moments ago. We have reproduced it below -

'KFANDRA has received statements from each of the players involved in the league match between TT and PCF played a few days ago, barring one or two. The high percentage of communications received had been deemed worthy enough for an assessment to be made. The Head Honchos along with Khare and some Media representatives sat together early this morning to take a final decision on whether to take one of the two extreme steps, which is to cancel the KLC4 outright or to cancel the KLC4 as it is set-up currently, and create a new player value system to initiate the purchasing and selling of players to create 'new Clubs' while at the same time appointing 'Player Managers'.

After much back and forth, and after much discussion over the statements made by the players, the KFANDRA Head Honchos concluded that every player registered with TT and PCF and those from PPP that were involved on that day and who wrote in, expressed sorrow at how the scenes unfolded on the lead up to match day and on match day itself. The Head Honcho's decided that the players must be given an opportunity to learn from mistakes made, for without a chance to learn, how can one know that if the same thing were to happen again, would the players commit the same mistake or show that they've made amends by taking note of what the right thing to do is?

They also stated that the players of TT and PCF can't be exonerated without being punished. They must understand that while forgiveness is divine, getting penalized for making a grave error is part and parcel of being forgiven and therefore being given a second chance.

This punishment though, can be cancelled outright if the the two Clubs decide on an alternative option, which is explained below.

Tenacious Turtles will be deducted a total of 3 points. 2 points for unanimously creating an alternative tactical plan to what is stated in the TT Blueprint and 1 point for not creating a strong mode of communication internally between the TT players.

Pune City Foxes will be deducted 1 point for 'thinking' of moving away from the PCF Blueprint and 1 more point for not creating a strong mode of communication internally between the PCF players.

The alternative to the deduction of points, is that the two Clubs fix a date for a re-match. Where-in all that would be taken away from Saturday's match are the lessons learnt and nothing else.

Oh yes, and one more thing, everyone is requested to read very carefully, the next article. Thank you!

A reminder to the KFANDRA member players! (This article was published on 10/01/23)

The two appointed Captains of each Club, PPP, PCF and TT have only one role, and that is to be the final decision makers in a democratic environment. They do NOT have any other powers. They are not allowed to arbitrarily make decisions on behalf of the Clubs they play for, without the players having gone through a democratic vote. They have been appointed by KFANDRA because they have shown themselves to be calm, mature and strong persons if caught in a tight corner. The tight corner for example being one where their teammates are hyper-ventilating due to the stress of a match coming up or currently being played. In the face of panic, these two Captains will be the players that will stick at all times to the ETHOS of KFANDRA and the Blueprints made for each Club. Every player must understand that their duty is to the Club and its rules governing tactical decisions, which basically is the Blueprint. No player has the authority to change anything in the Blueprint or go down another route, unless approved through a democratic vote. Which should never come about as the players should be too busy focusing on their

own job and as a unit, then on creating a new formula. Another tight corner is on which players to take on loan if the democratic vote taken is tied. When there is a ready-made Blueprint with options for every possible scenario, wouldn't it be easy for the players just to focus on the game? Why then does the player have time to worry about other things? The players must learn to allay doubts by communicating with their teammates and coming to a solution within the tactic laid out in the Blueprint. For eg, let's say a Club who we'll name as Dodgy Club, is playing against another Club, who we'll name as Meek United, and DC are worried about a player in MU. Player S in DC is crapping his pants because he's worried about Player X. What does he do? Does he create a new tactical plan outside of the DC Blueprint or work inside of the Blueprint? Working inside just means that he will have a chat with the players closest in his link and tell them to cover for him by keeping an eye out when he's in trouble. That's it! There's absolutely no need to create a new tactic at all. And if the tactic fails? Then the Blueprint will take the blame and the players are free to dance in the rain. Everyone in the KFANDRA staff hopes that all is well from here onwards.

KFANDRA lose patience! (This article was published on 11/01/23)

KFANDRA waited at least 24 hours for some feedback from TT and PCF about arranging a re-match and after receiving nothing, decided to cancel the option of a re-match and go ahead with the punishments.

As for PCF's match on Saturday, rumours abound that the match may be postponed. With one player missing for PCF, they'll need to loan 2 players from NSTTP, one outfield player and one GK. The problem is that there are only 10 players available from a total of 14 remaining players at KFANDRA. This means that when NSTTP loan 2 players to PCF, there will be no players available to perform MDD's (Match Day Duties), such as counting completed passes and BRE work.

KFANDRA stated that the longer PCF dilly-dally with choosing their loans, the higher chances there are that the match will get postponed.

PCF have been allowed till Thursday to send in their Preview, but have been asked to choose their loans asap.

The grapevine also suggests that if the match was to go ahead, the GK's of both teams would be asked to count the completed passes of their own teams while playing. One of the Head Honcho's was heard saying, 'those fellows are busy doing nothing anyway!'

M. Inamdar, who recently performed wonders for TT in goals a couple of weeks ago, will definitely have something to say to this particular Head Honcho.

Lack of discipline forces match postponement! (This article was published at 11.45 am on 12/01/23)

As everyone is aware, KFANDRA treats every player equally. Every single player is governed by the same rules and regulations that applies to everyone. There is no separate law for some and another one for others. Of course, if real-life issues get in the way, then these R and R will be adjusted to accommodate certain situations that can't be avoided. KFANDRA will always be ready and willing to ensure that a crisis situation in a players real-life, is dampened down a little bit by lifting off some pressure at KFANDRA, if KFANDRA is able to do so.

Problems arise when there are tight situations like the one this Saturday. Wherein PCF need two loans (they are missing Deo in a squad of 7 and will always need a GKLoan) and NSTTP have only 10 squad players available. NSTTP are at this moment in time ready to provide any 2 loans and go ahead with the match, obviously with the tactical advice afforded by Khare. One of the problems that has cropped up and has forced KFANDRA's hand is what would've actually needed a simple solution. The solution though, lies within KFANDRA's ETHOS. When each player abides by the ETHOS, the door is always open for forgiveness and a chance to move on. When a player ignores even the most basic of rules, then KFANDRA finds it difficult to trust the players. One of the players playing for NSTTP on Saturday, has failed to attend sessions on Tuesday and Thursday this week, without intimation. Without names being named, KFANDRA has decided that the 1st Leg Cup SF match on Saturday will be pushed ahead to Saturday the 21st of Jan. Due to TT's request to postpone their league fixture at Home to NSTTP, the Cup Sf 1st Leg fixture has been pushed to the 21st. TT are free to fix the league match against NSTTP on any free Tuesday or Thursday in the future before the end of the season. The KTA fixtures on Saturday will now not be opened for a KLC fixture as the Almighty Zoltan has expressed a lack of desire to do so. A reminder all 3 Clubs, fixtures can be inter-changed!

Postponement put on hold! (This article was published at 11.55 am on 12/01/23)

KFANDRA has just now received information that the player in question had valid reason for missing out on the sessions and provided proof that his messages were not delivered.

Although, he is still at fault for not checking the session sheets to check if his messages have been received, KFANDRA is giving the benefit of doubt to the player and giving the other KFANDRA players another chance.

The final decision on Saturday's match will be taken later today.

PCF still to send in Preview! (This article was published at 7 am on 13/01/23)

The Pune City Foxes should've been aware that regardless the decision by KFANDRA to cancel or postpone the match, they should still have sent in their preview. KFANDRA is not waiting for their preview to come in.

As of now the match is on!!

Rumours abound that PCF are scared and they've gone for Patwardhan as an outfield loan and Mishra as a GKL.

It's a pity that the top KFANDRA Clubs are not willing to invest in other available KFANDRA players. Their inclination to make a loan move for technically advanced players shows they are more interested in the result than hurting feelings.

KFANDRA website remained offline for quite a while yesterday! (This article was published at 7 am on 13/01/23)

Many KFANDRA fans were left in a state of limbo as they couldn't connect to the KFANDRA website yesterday.

Word has it that the servers hosting the KFANDRA website were facing major issues and it was only till late in the day that that matter was resolved. All is good now!

The SF 1st Leg NSTTP v PCF is on! (This article was published at 7 am on 14/01/23)

KFANDRA has decided to go ahead with the fixture tomorrow!

The previews have been published!

In other news -

KFANDRA has asked Khare to look after NSTTP in light of events that happened last week internally between TT and PCF. KFANDRA has asked

Khare to referee and look after NSTTP as he used to do in the past. Khare has pounced on this opportunity as he sees this fixture as a Minnow Vs Whale fixture, or more appropriately, a skulk of foxes Vs a bunch of men armed with nothing but their bare hands.

Khare will send the match Blueprint to the NSTTP squad by 1 pm.

Pancholi gets a KFANDRA Club! (This article was published at 7 am on 14/01/23)

Dwarkesh 'Bernie' Pancholi has been registered with Pulsating Pune Panthers. He begins his life at PPP from this moment on.

PCF scrape through on Golden Goose Loan! (This article was published at 7 am on 14/01/23)

Pune City Foxes needed a Turtle and a Panther to get them a positive result this morning. Patwardhan a Tenacious Turtle Loan scored twice in the 2nd half, once in the 8th and again 4 mins before the final whistle. Sandwiching a Babhale lob that the Panther GK Loan Mishra managed to save. Earlier, M. Inamdar continued his sensational form by opening the scoring with 7 min 22 secs on the clock, and it was Sharma who equalized for NSTTP in the 1st min of the 2nd half.

A 3 - 1 win result looked flattering as NSTTP played better as a cobbled together squad than PCF looked as a Club side. NSTTP defended as if their lives depended on it while and played to the counter, while PCF got frustrated easily as wave after wave of attack kept being easily repelled by NSTTP. After a lot of flak in the media against PCF for loaning Patwardhan, a player that guarantees goals, PCF sought to prove to the hecklers that they could win without Patwardhan playing in midfield or attack. Their game-plan gave them 1 goal in the 1st half that M. Inamdar scored. But apart from that there was nothing much to write home about. In the 2nd H they pushed Patwardhan up front as he settled in, Patwardhan stole the Thunder. PCF were left with the victory, but no confidence of how to work things out as the KLC progresses. With this PFC victory, all NSTTP have to do now is win in their 2nd leg match.

Another exchange of matches? (This article was published at 7 am on 15/01/23)

Tenacious Turtles has expressed their desire to postpone their match on the coming Saturday while Pulsating Pune Panthers want to prepone their match. But neither of the Clubs have contacted KFANDRA yet with proposed dates. They must do so asap!

KFANDRA orders reduction of VCM's on match day! (This article was published on 16/01/23)

In the match between NSTTP and PCF, there were 5 video camera's set up by the KFANDRA Media team. As Khare was on his own (apart from S. Inamdar who tried to help as much as he could before departing at 7 am), the Kick OFF time was delayed. Khare had to run from one end of the ground to the other, to switch on the camera's. Then the same process when the 1st half ended, except this time, he had to switch them off to conserve the battery. At the start of the 2nd half, the same process to turn on the camera's had to be repeated. The time was further extended due to poor light, which meant the camera's couldn't be positioned at say, 6.15 or 6.45 am.

KFANDRA has informed the KMD that the videography must be sacrificed to ensure that the matches start at the scheduled time and end at a reasonable time too.

The KMD has stated that with there being no MDDO's available, the 5 fixed camera set up was supposed to plug the gaps created when only 1 or 2 cam's are used. But they are happy with this new ruling, as it was Khare himself who had to collect the camera's, upload them and recharge them again for the next match. And this is not counting his help which is required for the match highlights itself.

Thus, from the match on the 21st of Jan, this coming Saturday, only 2 or 3 camera's are to be used.

One player commented that he remembered the time when only 1 video camera was used to record the matches. The KMD wishes to remind this player that the fate of the highlights show rested on this player handling that one camera properly. Khare has faced many post-match days in a state of trauma, wondering how a shot of one lonely set of goalposts can represent a goal being scored at the other end. A few seconds later, the celebrating players are focused upon, as the cameraman realizes that he was following the game with his eyes and not the camera.

NSTTP v PPP preponed! (This article was published on 16/01/23)

The NSTTP v PPP league fixture to be played on the 28th of Jan has been preponed to the coming week Saturday, 21/01/23.

The TT v NSTTP fixture has been shifted temporarily to the 28th of Jan. As TT has not informed KFANDRA of their plans after asking for a postponement, KFANDRA has pushed the match to the 28th and allowed the preponement request, to give time for TT to look for another date or another exchange of dates.

King Mop and King Tan are requested to get confirmations from the Princes of the Northern and Southern Territories for the match on the 21st of Jan and contact KFANDRA with the number. Depending on the number of confirmations being at least 9 and above, the match will go ahead. If there are less Princes available to play, then TT will have to look for another date to play against NSTTP.

Coming up this new week, 2 events to thrill the taste buds, on Tuesday will be the NSTTP v PPP fixture and on Saturday will be the KTA2 event, if no KLC4 fixtures are scheduled.

A sensational beginning to the KTA! (This article was published on Saturday 22/01/23)

PCF docked points! TT asked to take decision! (This article was published on 30/01/23)

The KFANDRA Court met this afternoon after it was convened for an emergency session, when more light was shed on the NSTTP v TT fiasco. For those that are unaware, fans who purchased tickets for the match to be played tomorrow morning were astounded to the core on hearing of the postponement and then ended up being livid on discovering that the match could've, in fact, gone ahead. They raised the issue with The Almighty Zoltan who then contacted KFANDRA to get to the bottom of this affair. KFANDRA immediately broke up a very respectable lunch organized for the KFANDRA Judges by their wives and girlfriends. Thus, when the KFANDRA Court was convened, it wasn't surprising that the Judges were none to pleased and were looking to take their anger out on someone or some people.

What was tabled before the court was the following summation -

A certain Mr. Kadam of PPP began a conversation/chat on a social networking platform stating that he was ava to play for NSTTP v TT to be held on Tuesday the 30th of Jan. The evidence shows Mr. Kadam's name clearly mentioned on top of the list with space to fill up other names and also space to fill up players that were una and tentative. The advocate appointed by the Court to explain the entire matter, pointed out that a Mr. Khan of PCF, decided that the next best step was to 'delete' Mr. Kadam's message and begin a new conversation. Mr. Kadam confirmed this morning for tomorrow's session as the

match was scheduled to be postponed, but with a condition that he had to leave at 7.45 am. What this advocate wanted to know is why Mr. Kadam had failed to mention the same timing issue in his confirmation message? Is it that Mr. Kadam feels that playing a match is far more important than participating in a session? The advocate concluded that the highly respected KFANDRA Court Judges should punish all those involved. He then excused himself stating that he was late for a play-date.

After an hour of discussions, the KFANDRA Court came to the following decision -

PCF will be deducted 2 points for their involvement in this nonsensical episode. Khan of PCF is guilty of deleting the original message and thereby deleting Kadam's name from the list. King Mop of PCF, failed to notice this deletion of Kadam's name. Jobanputra though, could not be blamed as his excuse was a real-life problem and he had no other option but to pull out. Regrettably, it seems KFANDRA will never ever be able to compete with 'real-life' issues, even if the real-life issues aren't serious.

It must be remembered that this postponement fiasco has only come about because the ex-Quasi-Members, guests of KFANDRA, backed out of the KLC4 just as it was about to begin. The inclusion of ACU in the KLC4 had meant that KFANDRA could come up with a plan to ensure that each KFANDRA member would get a full game for every match they played in. Those of you that are unaware, KFANDRA had create multiple scenarios which focused on a KLC4 with internal modifications that was to be considered, if ACU had declined much earlier to participate in the KLC4. But it was too late to implement so close to the start of the season. Who was to know, that more than 3 players would be una on match dates?

KFANDRA has vowed, that if the membership at KFANDRA decreases or stays the same, then the KLC5 will be organized with the understanding that at least half a dozen players will remain absent on every match day.

Obviously, if the attendance increases, then this current pattern is good to go. TT and PCF have been asked to look for other dates to play this match and to inform KFANDRA by the end of the week.

As for this week, the teams for the short game league will be finalized on Thursday's session. KFANDRA has asked Khare to do the camera work and the players not playing will be reffing.

News just in -

KFANDRA even requested Mr. Surhud Khare to play for NSTTP to ensure that both matches could go ahead, but unfortunately, he declined.

TT sends cryptic message to KFANDRA! (This article was published on 31/01/23)

This morning KFANDRA received two dodgy emails from a TT player. Rather, the emails were sent yesterday and the KFANDRA staff read them this morning.

In the 1st email the message simply stated that TT would bow down humbly to KFANDRA and whatever decision it takes as TT is unworthy to take such important decisions as asking for a walkover. The 2nd email suddenly referred to a democratic vote the players had taken, in which the decision to postpone the match was made.

One drops in and one drops out! (This article was published on 03/02/23)

For tomorrow mornings quick-fire KFANDRA football and rugby tourney, Ghotge has just informed KFANDRA that he will be unable to attend. As luck would have it, yesterday, Patwardhan changed his 'tentative' attendance to 'available' and the attendee's for tomorrow's 'session' remain the same. The simplest thing that KFANDRA was then going to do, was slot Patwardhan into one of the teams with 3 players. Now, with Ghotge dropping out, Patwardhan will replace him, coincidentally in what was one of the 2 teams that had 3 players in it.

The teams are now -

The teams are -

Team 1 - Sarda, S. Inamdar and Pancholi.

Team 2 - Patwardhan, Karanth and M. Inamdar.

Team 3 - Sanghvi, Sawant, Jobanputra and Bhorde.

Team 4 - Deo, Mishra, Pardeshi and Babhale.

KFANDRA will most likely allow players to play on loan for the two teams with only 3 players. The rule for loans is simple. The players that have attended the most sessions over the previous 3 months will be taken for loans as per their standings. Each player has been asked to check their personal records and compare them with the players that are available tomorrow.

The football tourney will begin at 6.50 am and end at 7.30 am. The rugby tourney will begin at 7.40 am and end at 8.15 am.

In the football tourney, it will be an all play all once event. 6 matches of 5 mins each with a change-over at 2 mins 30 secs. The matches will be played over the full pitch with the rebound wall's placed in both goals. Points awarded only if the ball goes dead. Play continues if the ball rebounds off the rebound wall goal, but points are awarded for the goal. Players can play a 1 - 2 with one of the players standing outside of the ground. A 1 - 2 can be played with the fence. Winning team will get rewarded!

The rugby teams have been arranged by KFANDRA. To be played over the full pitch. Momentum contact rules created by KFANDRA will apply.

Conversions will not be a part of the game tomorrow as it takes up too much time. Neither will kicking for goal for a penalty awarded. The players can restart with a tap start after moving the ball 5 yards ahead of where the penalty was awarded. 3 man scrums that the team putting the ball in can call for a 'light-weight' or 'heavy' scrum.

It is compulsory to wear KFANDRA supplied gum-shields during the rugby match and KFANDRA approved shin pads during the football tournament.

Team 1 - Forwards - Jobanputra, Pancholi, Sawant, Backs - Patwardhan, S. Inamdar, Pardeshi, Babhale.

Team 2 - Forwards - Sarda, Sanghvi, Mishra, Backs - Bhorde, M. Inamdar, Karanth, Deo.

The end of NSTTP? (This article was published on 04/02/23)

KFANDRA is contemplating withdrawing NSTTP from the KLC4. More on this later, after KFANDRA initiates a democratic vote amongst the KFANDRA members and the results are given to the KFANDRA media.

'The Almighty Zoltan' castigates KFANDRA! (This article was published on 05/02/23)

'TAZ' was extremely upset the other day (yesterday) when he heard that KFANDRA was planning to cancel all NSTTP matches and withdraw the NSTTP from the KLC4. He immediately flew into a rage but calmed down as he was aware that rage is not something you can use when communicating with KFANDRA. After discussing matters with KFANDRA, he was able to put his view across.

KFANDRA released the following statement to the media -

'After discussing the issue with 'The Almighty Zoltan', we've both come to an agreement. Both entities believe that the organization of the NSTTP should not face the possibility of being withdrawn from the KLC4, only because some KFANDRA Prince's are unable to attend their matches. The questions that were top-most on everyone's minds were, 'why should the players available for the matches suffer at the hands of those that are unavailable? Shouldn't it be that those who are una for a match feel sad and bad that the match would go ahead without them? Regardless of how many players were attending?'

'The Almighty Zoltan' also stated that if NSTTP was to be cancelled, then so would the KTA events. He mentioned that he had a lot of pressing matters in the entire universe and multi-verses and it was only because of his 'trust' in KFANDRA that he deemed the KTA worthy of his time and attention. He also mentioned clearly that this was not a threat at all, but only a statement of truth. Taking everything into consideration, KFANDRA has decided to take the following steps.

NSTTP will not be withdrawn from the KLC4. In fact, a new rule for all KLC4 matches will be implemented. The rule is that henceforth, no postponements will be granted, unless 3 or more than 3 players are missing from the full

squad of 7. There will also be a limitation on the loans allowed. The 'Club' will only be allowed to loan one outfield player along with the GKloan. KFANDRA has stated that in case 2 players out of the squad of 7 are unavailable, then the concerned Club would require 3 loans to complete the squad of 8. As this is not permitted, the concerned Club will be asked to play the match with 7 players, basically 5 + 2 loans (1Of + 1Gk). This will automatically mean that if they are scheduled to play against NSTTP, then NSTTP will have to field 7 players too. In the case that there are less NSTTP players available for loan, then the concerned Club will be asked to take only a GKloan and play with 6 players. NSTTP then, will have to field 6 players too. If there are absolutely no extra players for NSTTP to loan, then the match will only go ahead if the concerned Club agrees to compulsorily play with a fixed GK or rotate their players as GK. In addition to these rules, the duration of the match will be reduced accordingly. For a 7 v 7 encounter, the match will be of 25 mins each half, for a 6 v 6 encounter, the match will be of 20 mins each half and for a 5 v 5 encounter, the match will be of 10 mins each half. Post the match, KFANDRA will use the remaining time to hold a session. With this, the spokesperson gave everyone a serious but wide smile and exited stage right.

The end of rugby for a year? (This article was published on 05/02/23)

After our sources found out that the rugby match in yesterday's 'Fun-Day' event was cancelled because there were a few players that couldn't hide their disappointment at playing rugby, KFANDRA was informed and has taken immediate steps to get to the bottom of the matter.

The KFANDRA members have been asked to submit a form stating their view on rugby being included, as has always been, as a regular part of KFANDRA training. The KFANDRA registration form will also include this additional form for new members before joining KFANDRA.

KFANDRA will always take steps to ensure that all the members are happy and treated fairly.

In case a large majority is unhappy with the current situation, the following steps will be taken. Rugby will only be taken in practice sessions, if the training is used in such a way that it improves the player's performance while playing football and for improving fitness levels.

The decision not to hold a KLCR tournament and also friendly rugby events will apply for 12 months from this date. Every year today, the same form will

have to be submitted by the players, after which a decision whether to continue as is or not, will be taken.

KFANDRA has stated that every human being is different and has varied likes and dislikes. KFANDRA has to find a way forward, wherein every member can be passionate about attending sessions every single time.

KFANDRA will always be about football and rugby. But in some cases or for some periods of time, serious rugby may have to be set aside.

KFANDRA will be disappointed if this were to happen, but the disappointment will not be reflected in the way it continues taking practice sessions and football tournaments, with the ETHOS fully entrenched.

Player's still responding! (This article was published on 06/02/23)

KFANDRA has kept the rugby training on hold for the time being as the form has as yet not been submitted by all the KFANDRA members.

The tally so far is an overwhelming response that rugby should continue. The issue which arises for KFANDRA, is that even with a couple or three or four naysayers, rugby isn't a sport that can be played with a half-hearted approach. Even though, the rules have been adjusted to avoid injuries, minor contact can be dangerous for players that aren't a 100% committed. Commitment levels and passion arise from within a person and can't be purchased. That's why, for eg, when the question is asked to the players as to who wants to play contact-momentum-walk rugby, and out of say 20, even if 4 players would rather play football, the plan to play rugby is cancelled. If the plan wasn't cancelled and the game went ahead with 4 unhappy players, the behaviour of the players would spread to the others and an unhealthy atmosphere is bound to develop. If those players that were unhappy were asked to do something else during the rugby training, this situation would become unhealthy too. A clear rift would appear between the players who enjoy rugby and the players that don't.

KFANDRA has spent almost 3 years to change the mindset of players that weren't inclined to play rugby, by making rugby compulsory. It has been pretty successful in this regard and could've continued down this path. The problem which has arisen is that the players that have shown interest in learning the ropes have improved, which means their training can become even tougher. This though, would be detrimental to those players that remain reluctant participants. While KFANDRA was full of spirit and purpose 3 years ago, 3 years is a long time and the spirit and purpose can take a lot of hits. Khare himself said, 'there's a difference between seeing how all the players react

positively during a session and then when you see a few sourpuss faces amongst them. As a coach your mood drops! And that's unfair on those that have enjoyed every aspect of the session. You begin to wonder if the players that are unhappy are playing because they don't want to disappoint you, or they're reluctant to tell you their innermost thoughts because of the way you may react, or because they don't want their teammates to look down upon them. That's why my job as a coach and manager becomes all the more important. You see, KFANDRA is a getting together of like-minded individuals who are looking up to KFANDRA for direction. If you bring into the mix a few players that aren't as like-minded as the others, then that's when fissures between the players are created. There's only two options left for me now, to either ask those players to leave as they do not abide by the KFANDRA policy to coach both football and rugby or two keep everyone together by removing the one thing that is causing the rift, and that is rugby. What can be done though, is to; as has always been done at KFANDRA, use rugby as a training too to work on and improve the football skills of a player. I'll be in talks with KFANDRA about the next steps. Thank you!

A KFANDRA spokesperson added, 'KFANDRA will indeed try and include some rugby training over some sessions. But such that it won't affect the bonhomie of the players. We'll ensure that this does not happen. You see, in the end, KFANDRA would be bowing down to the few for the bigger picture, when it shouldn't bowing down for anyone. That's why we aren't terming it as a 'bowing down', but instead as stepping aside for the moment, while searching for a solution that can include both sets of players'.

As of now, rugby training is on hold. Once all the submissions come in, the news will be updated.

The players slog through the 6 minute kill drill 4 times this morning! (This article was published on 07/02/23)

With 4 players dropping out of this morning's session, KFANDRA held back the release of the 'advanced S and C audio clips' that were to be heard for the first time ever, on the ground this morning. Instead of the promised 30 minutes of pure hell with the adv. S and C clips, Khare decided to substitute it with the 6 min kill drill, levels 1 and 2 for the upper body, along with levels 1 and 2 for the lower body. This is the first time ever both the levels were combined at one time. The players were afforded a longer break between levels, but the S and C drill lived up to its moniker, of being a kill drill.

No doubt, the players will be fast asleep for quite a long time today or tonight or both!

Khare has promised though, that the count for some of the drills in the 'kill-drill' will be made more palatable and won't resemble the count that only a super-being could follow.

The 'kill-drill' was followed by some ball control work and full game tactical!

Two players fail to submit form, but vote is clear! (This article was published on 07/02/23)

The player vote concerning whether rugby should be played seriously at KFANDRA, was tallied this morning and to KFANDRA's pleasant surprise, a majority favoured the continuation of rugby coaching as a separate sport/discipline. A few hiccups were the minority, that were disinterested in a 'proper KLCR or rugby tournament', even if played under the specific KFANDRA rugby rules. KFANDRA has promised the players that the practice sessions during the monsoon will never be held on mucky and muddy pitches. If booking a ground for 3 sessions is beyond KFANDRA's reach, the 3rd session will be kept aside for road running or hill running, while working with the ball at times. Basically, a short-game football tournament with KLC rules was already mentioned when the short-game invitational tourney was held before the KLC3 prize distribution and pre the KLC4 season. What was also always on the cards was a quick short sided rugby tourney.

After considering all the responses, KFANDRA has decided to hold a serious rugby session for a max of 30 mins only twice or three times every month.

Rugby will be taken at the end of the session. The players that do not want to participate in the 'rugby' part of the session, will be given permission to play

football short-game, play 3-and-in or some other drill that is approved by the Coach. Permission to leave the ground early will also be granted, as it is granted anyway for some players that have to leave for real-life work issues. While playing rugby and football on an Astro-turf pitch will be difficult, it isn't impossible and something will be planned. In situations where there aren't enough football enthusiasts or the football inclined players want to join the rugby players, the switch will be permitted. If there aren't enough rugby enthusiasts than the rugby part of the session will be cancelled for that session and football will be taken. As for the KLCR, a tournament as such will not be held. Only one-off matches or one session tourney's will be held with possibly some prizes to be awarded.

KFANDRA is thrilled that a solution could be reached. Some may say that rugby got the short end of the stick, but in a 'football crazed environment', KFANDRA feels that this plan, is way, way better than nothing at all.
