## Dear Parents/Carers,

The first half-term has flown by and we have enjoyed a very positive start to the year. I am delighted to report that our new Year 7 pupils have made a fantastic start to their life at Risca CCS. It was a pleasure to witness their outstanding behaviour and high levels of resilience in lessons during our recent whole school Pupil Progress Review. This was mirrored across all year groups and our Risca Learning Charter was strongly evident in all lessons observed. After a challenging start to the year our attendance figure is rising and we are currently standing at 92%, almost 1% above the average for Secondary Schools across Wales. Thank you for your support in relation to our school uniform. The minor adaptations introduced this year have had a very positive impact.
