- During tutoring, students can:
  - Get extra help or practice on current or past concepts (even from previous grades)
  - Complete current or missing assignments
  - Take notes from absent days
  - Re-take assessments

### Homework:

- **Workbook**
  - There are usually 2-5 problems assigned each night that should take no more than 20 minutes
    - If taking longer, have your student stop and ask questions the following day. It is not good for students to be frustrated as they will not learn and end up disliking the subject.
- **iReady**
  - Students may be assigned iReady lessons in an effort to help them review previous learning or fill in possible learning gaps
    - If assigned, they are usually given 2 days to complete one assignment
- **Delta Math or Khan Academy**
  - Students will be assigned work in one of these online systems if extra practice towards fluency is necessary
