Reminder from the Nurse's Office

Flu (Influenza) Vaccine is required by the State of Connecticut for all enrolled preschool students. The nurse's office must have documentation of flu vaccine for your child on file, administered between August 1st, 2025, and December 31st, 2025. The State requirement is one dose for children who have received the vaccine before, and 2 doses for children receiving the vaccine for the first time. Students out of compliance after December 31st will be held out of school.

🏃 🏃 🏃 Our Franklin students were amazing this past weekend at the state cross country meet! There were a total of 2200 middle schoolers running this weekend in 6 different races.

Boys A race (with runners from across the state, 2.3 miles): Top 50 get medals in each race

- **Brayden Walsh was 33 out of 397 overall,**
- **Larson Ayer was 155 out of 397 and beat his time from last year by 1 min 18 seconds.**
- **Greyson Gorra was 271 out of 397**
- **Eli Raymond was 287 out of 397**

Girls B race (with runners from the eastern half of the state, 1.7 miles): Top 50 get medals

- **Adilyn Weckwerth won the race out of 283 girls!**
- **Hallie Gorra was 3 out of 283**
- **Audrey Konow was 14 out of 283**
- **Aubrey Stearns was 156 out of 283 (running faster pace every race)**

Boys B race (with runners from eastern half of the state, 1.7 miles): Top 50 get medals

- **Camden Nash was 49 out of 278 runners**

Out of our 9 runners, 5 of them were top 50 in their race and got medals.
