## A Typical Day in E-cademy+

While every day in a classroom is different, there is still a general structure of how a day is planned. In E-cademy+ for elementary we will still have timetables, school start and end times, and lunch and break times.

Below is an example of what a day may look like for a grade 4/5/6 student. Teachers will be making the final timetables for their classes. This is only an example.
