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# **EL School Title III Plan Updates:**

The English Learner (EL) Guidance Manual is now available. This manual was developed by the Office of Student Support Services (OSSS) English Learner (EL) team in collaboration with the EL Advisory Group comprised of school, complex, and complex area representatives. In addition, the manual has been vetted by several state offices within HIDOE.

The manual serves multiple purposes. It provides guidance and a legal basis, as well
as processes, tools, forms, and resources that will support schools and complex
areas in meeting EL-related federal and state obligations. The manual also includes
guidance from previous HIDOE memos and the 2012 Identification, Assessment, and
Program Placement System for English Learners, and has been updated to reflect
the changes in practice and law.
