Speaker and Audience:

Who said this? Who is it said to and what is the purpose?

Context:

What is happening in the story when it is being said?

Significance:

What does the quote mean? What does it reveal about the characters/conflict/theme?

Connections:

What does this quote mean to you? How do you see this idea in the world?

## Putting it all together:

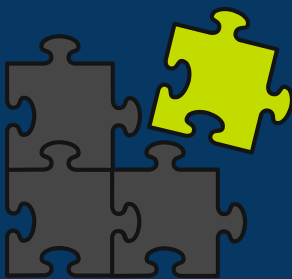


Introduce the quote:  
When (event from the book-**context**) happened,  
(character's name-**speaker**)  
says...

Paraphrase:  
"In other words..."

Analyze:  
Explain significance,  
tone/mood, literary device:  
"The author is trying to  
make us see that..."

Evaluate:  
Why is this quote  
important? What real world  
applications and  
connections can be drawn  
from the meaning of the  
quote?  
"This story/passage had a  
significant impact on my  
thinking about..."
