Before You Meet Your New Student

- Pray for them by name
- Enlist someone else to pray for them during the meeting
- Clearly establish the place and time to meet
- Identify how they will be able to recognize you
- Give them your cell phone number in case of last-minute changes

When You Meet Your New Student

- Introduce yourself and your partner
- Find a comfortable place to talk
- Ask them about their background, family, major, hometown,
- Thank them for coming to the BCM or the BCM Event
- Ask “How did you find out about the BCM or the Event?”
- Ask “What did you like about the experience?”
- Ask “Do you mind if we tell you who we are and what we value as a student organization?”

Who We Are

- We are a student organization and ministry
- We are student led and staff supported
- We are supported by the Florida Baptist Convention, local churches, alumni and friends

- We believe students need to be connected to a local multi-generational body of believers in a local church setting

Discovery Questions

- Has anyone ever shared the gospel of Jesus with you?
 - No – Share the gospel using the GA sheet or your favorite method
 - Yes – What was your response to the gospel when shared with you?
 - No – “would you share with me what you think someone needs to do to be saved and go to heaven based on what was shared with you?” Share the gospel again if appropriate

- Yes – “That’s awesome would you share with us how your faith in Jesus has grown since then?”
- “Has anyone ever taken the time to help you understand how to grow in your walk with the Lord?”
 - Yes – “Do you feel you are in a place to help disciple other students who might need someone to help them grow in their faith?”
 - No – “Would you be interested in meeting with someone on a regular basis to help you learn to grow in your faith?”
- “Are there any questions that you have about who we are and what we believe that we haven’t touched on?”
- “Would you like to meet with one of our Ministry Partners or our Director?”

Next Steps to get involved with the BCM

- Event entry – Invite them to Gator and Connection Group
- Gator entry – Invite them to Connection Group
- Connection Group entry – Invite them to Gator
- All entries – Can we help you connect to a local church and arrange a ride if you need one for this Sunday?
