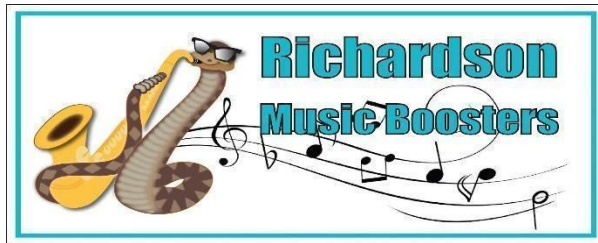


Richardson Music Boosters General Meeting Notes (Winter Concert)

- **Financial update from Hannah:** Current Banking balance is \$29,779.48. At the beginning of the school year we projected that our Music Boosters would need to raise around \$35,700.00 to support our music program and continue to provide events like the Forum of Festival at Knott's, the Disneyland workshop, as well as continue to meet the needs of the providing quality music program and ensure our equipment and instruments are maintained. This year we have raised a total of \$11,285 through direct donations, our Charleston Wrap and See's Candies Fundraisers and sales of Jamba Juice and Krispy Kreme BOGO cards. To reach our funding raising goal of \$35,700.00, we still need to raise another \$24,000.00 Hannah appealed to those present to continue to support Music Boosters and encourage your students to spread the word to family and friends. There will be another Fundraising opportunity through See's Candies for Valentine's day.
- **Additional Funding Raising and other Announcements provided by Jillian Wade:** BOGO Jamba Juice and Krispy Kreme cards continue to ongoing fundraising opportunities. Krispy Kreme cards were available for sale for \$24.00 and Jambo Juice cards for \$11.00 were also available for sale at the concession tables.
