

Internet Access Options:

Moore County Schools has multiple options to assist students without reliable Internet access at home.

Check-Out Hot Spots:

- Please reach out to your student's school for more information on requesting a hot spot.
- Please note that these devices are restricted for use only with Moore County Schools student devices, and may have monthly data limits (and thus should be used only to continue schoolwork).

Drive-Up WiFi Access:

Free WiFi

- Other Internet access options include Free WiFi available at local businesses and community centers.
- Please note that some of these sites may be restricting community access, but may be accessed from vehicles in parking lots or nearby.
