

1. (Easy) Main Nonprofit Website: Nonprofit Public Information: designersforlearning.org
 - a. Static Information (Brochure-ish)
 - b. Collect Donations (I wish)
 - c. Contact Form
2. Service-Learning Collaboration Platform ("LMS"-ish): studio.designersforlearning.org
 - a. (Easy-ish) Features needed for EACH project (separate menu, groups, etc.)
 - i. Static content
 - ii. Discussion forum (bbpress)
 - iii. Deliverables:
 1. Submission of deliverables (form plugin)
 2. Multi-person evaluation / feedback (currently SurveyMonkey)
 - iv. Event calendar (event plugin)
 - v. Links to other content (linkies)
 - vi. Recognition:
 1. Letter of Recognition: Students and Faculty (process off-line)
 2. Badges?
 - b. (Hard) Manage *multiple* service-learning projects on "platform" containing all projects (think p2pu-ish)
 - i. Do all of the above, but also ...
 - ii. Ability to see all courses on a main menu
 - iii. Single login (participants may participate in multiple projects)
3. (Hard) Client Project "LMS" Platforms
 - a. Where students develop / post final deliverables they design - for 15 week projects becomes more of a prototype site
 - b. Low Cost (No cost is fine if we can export)
 - c. Easy entry for student developers & clients who will take over when we are done
 - d. Some of the typical "LMS" stuff, but don't need much (most of the time)
 - i. Always Need
 1. Posting / Access to static content (e.g. <http://hopelearning.weebly.com/ged-preparation.html>)
 2. Hmm ... the rest appears sometimes nice to have :)

 1. Enrollment / Student Tracking
 2. Discussion features

 - viii. Facilitators
 - b. Tracking based on, such things as

 - c. Contents:
 - i. Basic contact info
 - ii. Notes, including application data
