



Voter Readiness and Pre-Registration

This voter pre-registration workshop explores young people's attitudes toward voting and the issues that concern them. The workshop emphasizes the positive impact of increased youth turnout and the things young people can do — registering to vote, sharing their decision on social media, and even conducting their own pre-registration drive — to amplify their political concerns. The activities reinforce the powerful message that young people can and should have a voice in shaping the kind of society they want to live in. The practical how-tos of registering to vote are included!

Facilitating voter readiness

*This workshop is for teachers, youth service professionals, and youth leaders who want to effectively engage young people in an exploration of their attitudes toward voting and the issues that concern them. The emphasis of the workshop is on identifying the social and practical barriers that young voters face and the positive effects of increased voter youth registration and turnout. **Participants will receive the Google slides and all materials (except registration forms) necessary to lead a one-hour workshop for students or two half-hour workshops (perfect for advisory!).** The practical how-tos of registering to vote are included.*

Relational Organizing

This workshop is for anyone who wants to effectively engage friends, family, and acquaintances to take action on an issue, whether it is a ballot measure or a community effort. The emphasis of the workshop is to understand how relational organizing works and build each participant's confidence to activate their social network. Practical how-tos of developing an approach for texting or talking about issues are included.
