## Speaker: Antony Stately, PhD, LP



Antony Stately, PhD (Enrolled Citizen of Oneida Nation of Wisconsin; Descendent of White Earth and Red Lake Ojibwe Nations) received his PhD in Clinical Psychology from the California School of Professional Psychology at Alliant International University in 1997. He is the Chief Executive Officer for the Native American Community Clinic – a Federally Qualified Healthcare Center in South Minneapolis – which provides primary care, dental care, and behavioral health and substance abuse services to the Twin Cities American Indian community, a role he has held since December 2016.

Dr. Stately has served and worked in many community-based organizations and programs in clinical and prevention services, and has been a research scientist at the Indigenous Wellness Research Institute at University of Washington-Seattle (from 2004-2009). He has taught in clinical psychology and social work graduate program, and has served as a consultant and advisor to numerous federal and state agencies, NGOs and non-profits delivering health services to tribal and indigenous communities nationally and internationally. He serves on the Metropolitan Urban Indian Directors (MUID) group, and on the board of the Indigenous Peoples Task Force.
