Keywords: mention only specific concepts [word or phrase], 3-5 concepts, truly conceptual words, and not too general ones.

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Introduction

Your text is here, in 11 pt font size, with 1.0 line spacing; Do not add space before and/or after the paragraph. It is much better to not format your text in a specific technique, instead, just leave it plain except that you really need to type certain words in a “special method”, or to emphasize certain words. Italic is a must in typing non-English terms. All Arabic words should be transliterated according to the style of the International Journal of Middle East Studies (IJMES), available for download in PDF file format [url:].

Explore in more words the background of your paper and your current research position among other research on related themes. You should provide the literature review here. This paragraph is designed to pinpoint the position of your article with recent publications; especially on the freshest and most relevant investigations published in high-reputation journals.

To put it another way, please try to answer at least two questions: *First*, why do you believe that your research question is such important to answer; *Second*, how do other scholars have or have not answered, or how do you think your answer would be a contribution to the existing scholarship on the subject.

A detailed description of your methods in doing the research is not necessary to write down in this section, but if you think you have to do so, you may mention it in short.

A considerable amount of exploration of the flows of your discussion and the expected final results might be a good point for closing this introduction section.

The First Section of the Discussion

Here you may discuss every aspect of the issue one by one. It is necessary to build an argument and to provide original data discussed and compared to research and works of other scholars. In other words, the way to

discuss an issue here is by combining the data and the discussion. So, it is not recommended to separate merely data description from the analysis on it.

Each quotation is written down in a specific way which could be identified as a “quotation” different from your original text. At the end of every quotation, you have to put its references in the footnote style of Turabian 8th style (full edition). A reference must also be put at the end of every citation that paraphrases ideas from someone’s works. If the citation is taken from a book, it must be like this,¹ and the subsequent citation is like this.² A book with volumes³ cited in a subsequent note;⁴ please note that the footnote reference number is placed after [not before] any punctuation. Citations from any previous references, but not subsequently cited, are noted like this.⁵ Mention only the last name of the author and the main title of the work.

The Second Section of the Discussion

Examples of references other than books are papers in academic journals,⁶ such as this one,⁷ websites,⁸ magazines and newspapers,⁹

reports,¹⁰ book chapters,¹¹ a master thesis,¹² and a Ph.D. thesis.¹³ The citation of Arabic literature is written and transliterated into Latin letters.¹⁴ Provide an URL whenever available along with the date of access (see footnote 8).

The Third Section of the Discussion

It is possible to add sections as needed. A section may consist of several sub-sections, typed in bold-italic and numbered list style, like the following example.

A. Sub-Section as Part of Its Parent Section

You do not need to add any special indentation in typing body text under the sub-section heading. The body text here is typed just like any other body text.

B. Another Sub-Section

You are strongly not recommended to make other sub-headings under this sub-section, even if you are allowed to do so. Instead, arrange the

discussion in narrative paragraphs. In addition, the listing style (1, 2, 3, ...) of paragraphs is not suggested.

C. Figure and Other Illustrations

Illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than divided at the end of the discussion. Each of them must be asserted with a brief description. If you need to include any table, figure, image, or other illustration, provide a high-resolution picture file as an attachment for your submission file. It is preferable for the editors, however, if you convert such figures and illustrations into narratives and do not include any pictures in your paper.

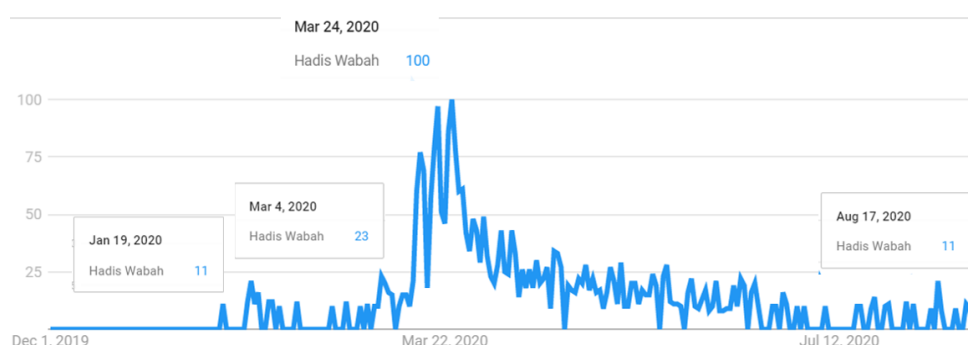

No.	Terminology	Explanation
1	Interest Over Time	is a graphic displaying the trajectory of a particular query within a particular period that is used as the keyword by the public in a particular space in the Google search machine
2	Relative Popularity	is the numerical figure (scale of 0-100) situated at the left side of the vertical line in the 'interest over time' graphic that shows the relative popularity of a particular keyword in a particular area. Accordingly, it is not an absolute figure of the search for the keyword in the area.
3	Interest by subregion	is a geographical map that displays the distribution of particular keywords searched through Google in a particular region. The more time a keyword is searched by Internet users in an area, the more the score it has. The score is decided as a numerical figure with a scale of 0-100, placed on the right side of the geographical map. The darker color indicates a higher score of search probability. Therefore, the more scores a keyword has, the darker the color, which means the more intense the use of the keyword has been.
