## 1. All questions are good questions.

In our community, there is no such thing as a "noob question". We want people to feel comfortable asking any question that comes to mind about anything unclear about Qwik. Our community members are patient, helpful and welcoming towards newcomers to make everyone feel at home.

### 2. Be respectful and inclusive
