1. Application process:

- A. Applicant will be nominated by a club or team.
- B. Applicant must have a recommendation from staff (Ms. Klein-Bedell will email the staff member for the recommendation).
- C. Applicant must have 2.5 GPA (cumulative, weighted)
- D. Applicant will submit the <u>online form</u>, making sure to upload a picture and signed contract. You must acknowledge that you read and agree to the terms and conditions by printing and signing the <u>Homecoming Court Contract.</u>
- E. Applicant must have good behavior, citizenship and attendance.
- F. Applicant must follow ROCKS and be a good representation of Lawndale High School

2. Approval of Candidates

3. Voting:

Up to* two Senior Royals from grade 12th will be elected based on who has the popular vote. All grades are eligible to vote for senior royals. Up to two additional royals will be selected from each grade by that grade level. Voting will take place virtually on Friday, October 17th.





*If there are 4 or more candidates, 2 will be selected. If there are 1-3 candidates, only one will be selected.

4. Presentation at Homecoming Game

Students must be present at the Homecoming Football game on 10/17/25. Royal Candidates will be presented at halftime Mandatory practice for the halftime show will take place on Tuesday, 10/14/25 on the track. Please meet in B-102.

5. Dance and coronation of the Royal HighnessesCrowning of the senior royals will be done at the football game halftime show. Junior, Sophomore, and Freshmen Royals will be announced at the dance on Saturday October 18th...

RULES FOR CAMPAIGNING

- 1. Campaigning can only be done October 13th 15th, 2025
- 2. Campaigning materials cannot exceed \$50.00
 - A. Receipts must be submitted before materials can be distributed or posted.
 - B. Costs of campaigning are the responsibility of the candidate.
 - C. Please note internet advertisements must be included in the overall \$50 campaign budget.
 - D. Even if campaigning materials are donated, candidates must include estimated prices in their receipt submission
 - E. All campaign material must be approved and stamped by the Associated Student Body before being posted on campus. (Candidates should be aware of posting policies on campus. You can view the poster policies and tips here)
- 3. Each Candidate can have 3 big posters (28 x 22 in) an unlimited number of flyers.
- 4. All advertisements including *t-shirts, banners, flyers, etc.* Must include the days designated for campaigning.
 - a. You may not give out candy, food, drinks, etc. and you may not give out stickers.
- 5. Social Media Rules:

- All campaign pictures must include the ASB stamp (see rule #4)
- In all campaign posts, you must tag the Lawndale ASB social media
- 6. Candidates may not tear down other candidate's campaign materials (flyers, posters, banners etc.) If candidates are seen doing so, they will immediately go through disqualification processes. You are responsible for your campaigning group's actions.
- 7. Campaigning cannot be done before or after the specified campaign days or you will be disqualified.
- 8. Royalty Candidates may choose to run with one another. If you choose to run with another candidate, materials will be counted together. (Limit is \$100.)
- 9. Physical advertising materials must be taken down Thursday, October 16th by 4:00 pm.
