## Statesville Branch NAACP Scholarship Eligibility Criteria, Rules and Regulations

---

1. The recipient must be a current High School Graduating Senior. To qualify, you must complete all the requirements in this Application.
2. Applications must be received by the deadline date of **April 25, 2025**.
3. Applicants must possess a grade point average of **2.0 in a 4.0 system**. A transcript clearly stating the applicant's average must be submitted to verify the grade point average.
4. The recipient must be a full-time student in a 2-year or 4-year college or university or a federally approved technical training school. After receiving proof of enrollment, five scholarships amounting to \$1000.00 will be issued to 5 recipients.
5. The following materials are to be submitted in one package:
  - a. Completed Application.
  - b. A typed 150-250 word essay (Choose one of the topics noted on the application form).
  - c. Official transcript including, if taken, SAT or ACT scores.
  - d. Evidence of acceptance by a college, university, or federally approved technical school.
  - e. A non-returnable recent photograph and a short, typed biography about yourself.
  - f. Two letters of recommendation (consider: counselor, minister, employer, teacher, community leader, etc.)
- 6. The application package must be hand delivered by the deadline to one of the Education Committee Members of Statesville Branch NAACP 5454 or sent via Courier to 549 North Race Street, Attn. M. Scott, or mailed to Statesville Branch NAACP, Post Office Box 1746, Statesville, NC 28687.**

### JUDGING:

1. The Statesville Branch Education Committee will evaluate all applications and choose finalists.
2. *(Optional, based on committee request) The Education Committee will decide if the candidates need an interview, and the Education Chairperson will contact the finalists to set an appointment.*
3. The maximum number of scholarships awarded in a calendar year is **five (5)**. Each scholarship will be \$1,000.00. Priority will be given to graduating seniors and first-time applicants.
4. Scholarship winner(s) will be announced at the Freedom Fund and Awards Banquet on the 3rd Sunday, May. **Your attendance at this event is requested. Each Scholarship recipient ticket will be free,** and the cost for additional family members to attend is \$50.00.
5. Scholarship recipients will be notified of the distribution process of the scholarship check.
