DRAMATIZATION

1. Paul and Barnabas are invited to speak at a synagogue, but some Jews argue with Paul and insult him.
2. Paul and Barnabas leave the synagogue to offer the gospel to the Gentiles.
3. Some Jews stir up a mob against Paul and Barnabas and they are chased out of town.

QUESTIONS

1. Why did Paul first present the gospel in the synagogue?
2. Why did some Jews oppose Paul and argue with him?
3. What can we learn from the way the Christians in Antioch of Pisidia respond to the opposition that Paul and Barnabas experienced?

4. What parts of this passage are most interesting to you?
