

Square of Sevens Pattern

A Free Pattern on Ravelry

This works up quickly and is a great pattern for a blanket.

Stitches to know: Chain, double crochet

Foundation row: **Even** multiples of 7

Row 1: Skip 3, (counts as first stitch) dc in each of the next 8 chains, [(ch 1, sk 1, dc in next chain) 3x , dc in each of the next 7 chains] repeat until 2 from end. Dc into each of the last 2 chains. Chain 3, turn

Row 2: Skip first dc, dc in each of the next 8 dc, [(ch 1, sk 1, dc in next dc) 3x , 1 dc in each of the 7 dcs] repeat until 2 from end. Dc into each of the last 2 dcs. Chain 3, turn

Row 3: Repeat row 2.

Row 4: Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dcs, (ch 1, sk 1, dc in next dc) 3x, [1 dc in each of the next 7 stitches, (ch 1, sk 1, dc in next dc)] until 2 from end. Dc in next 2 dcs. Chain 3, turn.

Row 5 &6, Repeat row 4.

Alternate repeating Row 2 three times, and row 4 three times (for best look, end on three Row 2's) until desired length.

Bind off.

Border as desired.
