Be it enacted by the Associated Students at the University of New Mexico that the following be amended in *(Section 3105)* of the ASUNM *(*Law Book*)*:

Section 3105. Outreach Duties

- A. At a minimum of one time a month during each session, the Vice President and President Pro Tempore shall assist the President in preparing an email message to inform the undergraduate student population about information regarding ASUNM initiatives and events, student issues, and upcoming ASUNM plans that promote knowledge and education on undergraduate subjects.
- B. The Vice President shall provide the President with a report concerning the legislative matters that would contribute to the overall goals of the email message.
- C. The report should be submitted to the president no less than three (3) days before the e-mail is to be delivered.
- D. The President, the Vice President, and the President Pro Tempore shall agree on the content prior to making the e-mail message public.
- A. At a minimum of one time a month during each session, the Vice President and President Pro Tempore shall assist the President in preparing an email message to inform the undergraduate student population about information regarding ASUNM initiatives and events, student issues, and upcoming ASUNM plans that promote knowledge and education on undergraduate subjects.
 - a. The Vice President shall provide the President with a report concerning the legislative matters that would contribute to the overall goals of the email message.

- b. The report should be submitted to the president no less than three (3) days before the e-mail is to be delivered.
- c. The President, the Vice President, and the President Pro Tempore shall agree on the content prior to making the e-mail message public.
- B. The Vice President shall work with the President Pro Tempore to create an email template for Senators to use in their bi-weekly outreach emails.
 - a. The Vice President shall work with the President Pro Tempore to determine the deadline as to when the bi-weekly emails are to be delivered.
 - b. This template should be delivered to Senators no less than two (2) days before the e-mails are to be sent.
